FUN SENSORY RECIPES TO BEAT CABIN FEVER!

CINNAMON DOUGH: 2 cups flour 1 cup salt ³/₄ to 1 cup warm water 5 tsp Cinnamon *Mix flour, salt and cinnamon, make a well in center and pour in water. Mix with hands until dough forms a ball. Knead on lightly floured board until smooth. Wrap in plastic and refrigerate 20 minutes before using. Excellent for cookie cutter ornaments.

GOOP:

¹/₂ cup cornstarch ¹/₂ cup water Food coloring

• Mix cornstarch with water



PLAYDOUGH:

2 cups flour
1 Cup Salt
3 Tbs. Cream of Tartar
2 Tbs. Oil
2 Cups boiling water

KINETIC SAND:

2 Cups Sand ¹/₂ Bottle Shaving Cream

1 Box Baking Soda

*Add Shaving Cream to sand. Slowly add baking soda until the sand sticks together but not to your hands.

MUD:

3 parts Corn Starch 1 part Cocoa Mix Add water a little at a time



SLIME: ¹/₂ cup Elmers Glue 1 Cup Shaving Cream 1 Tbs. Contact Solution Baby Oil Add glue to a bowl. Add shaving Cream until there is no more glue. Add contact solution, and a bit of Baby Oil to make less sticky.
